

2022 Atlantic Indigenous Mentorship Network Funding Opportunities

Call for Applications: National Gathering of Graduate Students (NGGS) Travel Awards

Submission Deadline: April 22nd, 2022

Background

The Atlantic Indigenous Mentorship Network (Atlantic-IMN) is a 5-year mentorship program funded by the Institute of Indigenous Peoples' Health (IIPH) at the Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR). The CIHR-IIPH initiated the Indigenous Mentorship Network Program (IMNP) in 2017 to support research networks and capacity building for Indigenous health and wellness students and Indigenous early career researchers through culturally relevant learning opportunities and mentorship activities. The Atlantic-IMN is among seven regional networks and one national network operating across what is currently Canada. The Kausattumi (Inuttitut for 'the dawn') Grants Program is an initiative of the Atlantic-IMN that will provide financial support to Indigenous students and early career researchers.

Funds Available: Travel Awards

Travel awards of **\$1500** are available (\$2000 for students traveling from Labrador) for **Indigenous students** to attend the National Gathering of Graduate Students (NGGS), June 14th-15th, 2022 at Dakota Dunes Resort in Saskatchewan. **Priority will be given to presenters.**

Eligibility Requirements

- First Nations, Métis, and Inuit students enrolled in degree programs involving community-informed and supported Indigenous health research with the supervision of an Indigenous or allied health scholar at a post-secondary institution in Atlantic Canada.

Successful applicants are expected to participate in and contribute to Atlantic-IMN and broader IMNP activities.

State your last name and the type of application you are submitting (e.g., LastName_NGGS Awards) in the subject line. All applicants will be notified of their result by the end of May, 2022.
